MINUTES FOR THE JUNE 26,2003 SPECIAL HAWLEY CITY COUNCIL MEETING

The special meeting was called to order by the mayor, Billy Richardson at 7:00 pm.

David Newman provided the opening prayer, and the mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance.

GENERAL PUBLIC PRESENTATION- A representative from the Abilene Lion's Club was present. She has applied for a grant for a new roof for the Hawley Activity Center. She also stated they may help with weather radios for the citizens that do not have a smart phone.

Also present was the owner from Rust to Tin to provide a presentation for storm clean up.

Business Tabled from June 13,2023: Discuss and act on (if necessary)

- a. Insurance for 2023-2024 fiscal year and adding life insurance for part time employees – Logsdon Insurance Agency provided a presentation on their health insurance benefits. A motion was made by Frank to table the decision on changing health insurance companies. Daniel provided the second, all approved, the motion carried to table the decision on insurance companies.
- b. Hiring personnel for storm clean up – After council discussed options, a decision was made to pay for clean up from the storm.
- c. Ambulance Service – this item was tabled for further information from Metro. David made the motion to table, Daniel provided the second. All agreed and the motion carried.

- d. Hiring Jonathan Bushee to control the feral cat population in the city limits- the motion was tabled. Frank made the motion to table, David provided the second. All agreed and the motion passed.
- e. Toronado and emergency siren for the city – Discussion was held about the high cost of an emergency siren (\$30,000). Discussed purchasing weather radios for citizens in the city. The Lion’s Club representative spoke and said that is possible something they could purchase. Daniel made the motion to not purchase the emergency siren and get the weather radios, Jason seconded the motion. All approved and the motion carried.

Daniel made the motion to adjourn, and Jason provided the second. All agreed and the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 pm.
